EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
BCJ - Quarterly Monitoring & Compliance Report
(April– June 2022)

During the period April to June 2022 five (5) Notices of Breach of Licence were issued, one (1) to a broadcast television licensee, and four (4) to broadcast radio licensees. There was no citation of breaches for the previous quarter, January to March 2022, therefore, there was an increase of five (5) when compared with the previous quarter

Thirty-seven (37) contacts were recorded for the period April – June 2022. Of this number, four (4) were complaints, which resulted in investigations of broadcast radio operators.

Thirty-three (33) were queries and comments about other operational issues pertaining to licensed operators and the work of the Commission.

All four (4) complaints were matters relating to content standards. There was a decrease of four (4) when compared with the previous quarter, January– March 2022.

Technical monitoring of twenty-four (24) broadcast licensees were done during this quarter, to capture their coverage in the parish of Clarendon.

In relation to the payment of the annual licence fee, fifteen (15) subscriber television (STVO's) operators, or 37% of all licensees paid in full; nine (9) or 22% made partial payments and seventeen (17) or 41% were non-compliant. There was a decrease in the number of full payments recorded when compared to the previous quarter. There was an increase of seven (7) in number of licensees who made partial payments and there was a decrease of eight (8) in the number of non-compliant licensees.

INTRODUCTION

Contacts with the Commission

Thirty-seven (37) contacts were recorded for the period, April – June 2022. There were four (4) content standard investigations and five (5) Notices of Breach of Licence.

PROGRAMMING CONTENT COMPLIANCE

The Commission investigated four (4) complaints relating to the broadcast of problematic content. The number of complaints investigated decreased by four (4) when compared to the period January – March 2022.

Table 1 details the complaints investigated relating to content standards between April to June, and the nature of the investigations conducted by the Commission.

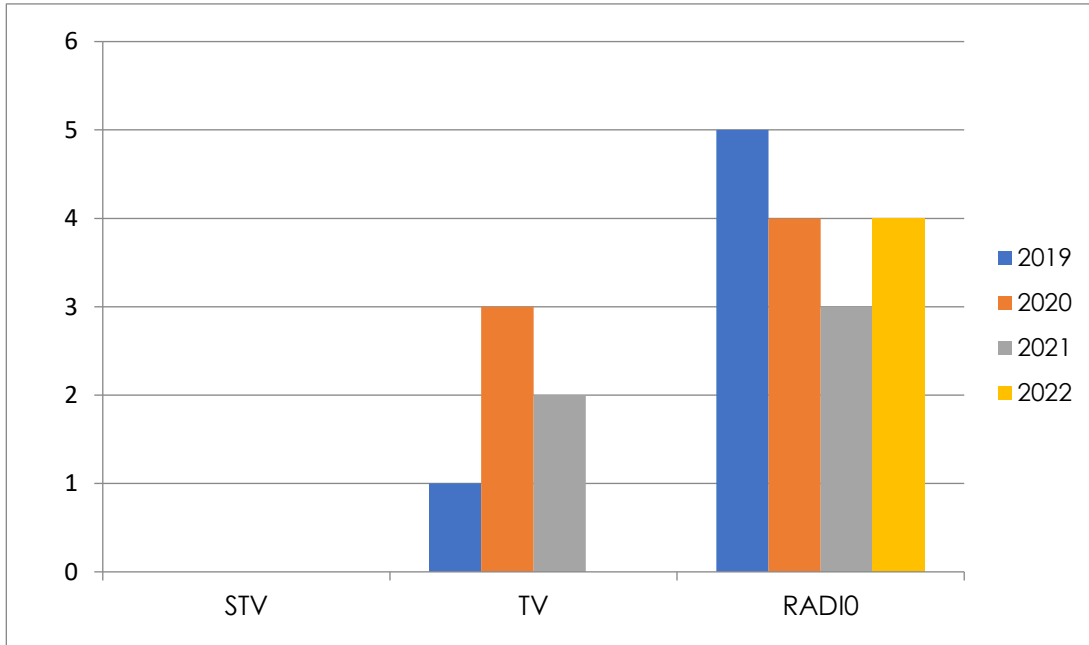

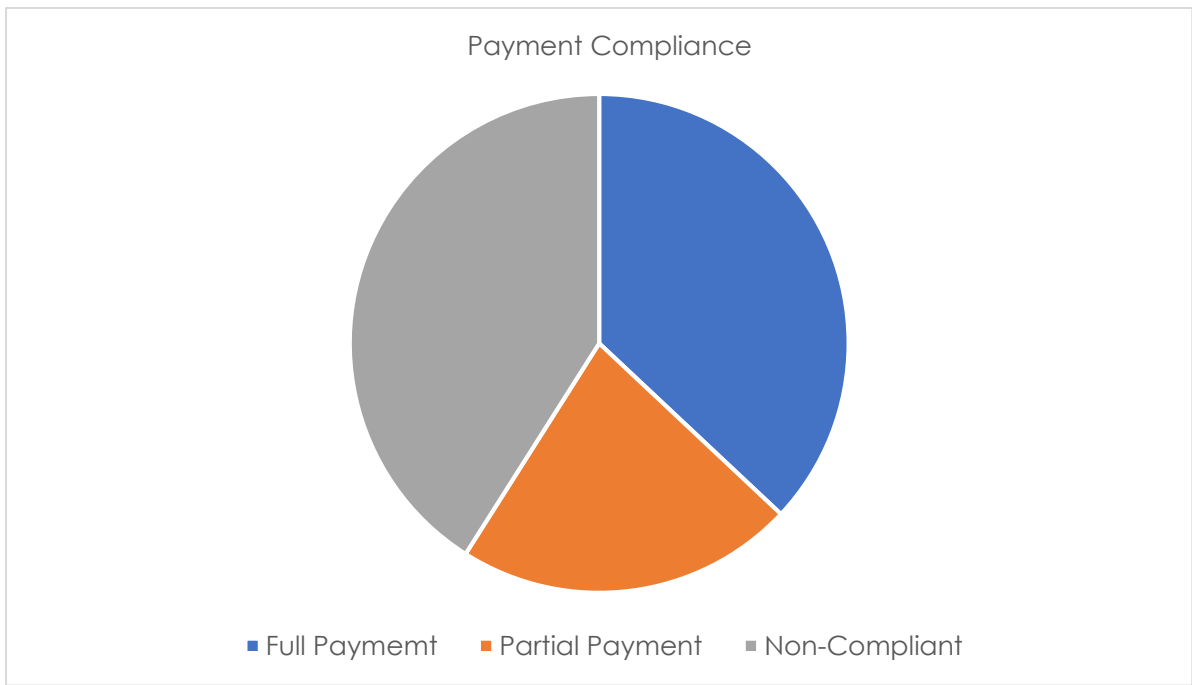

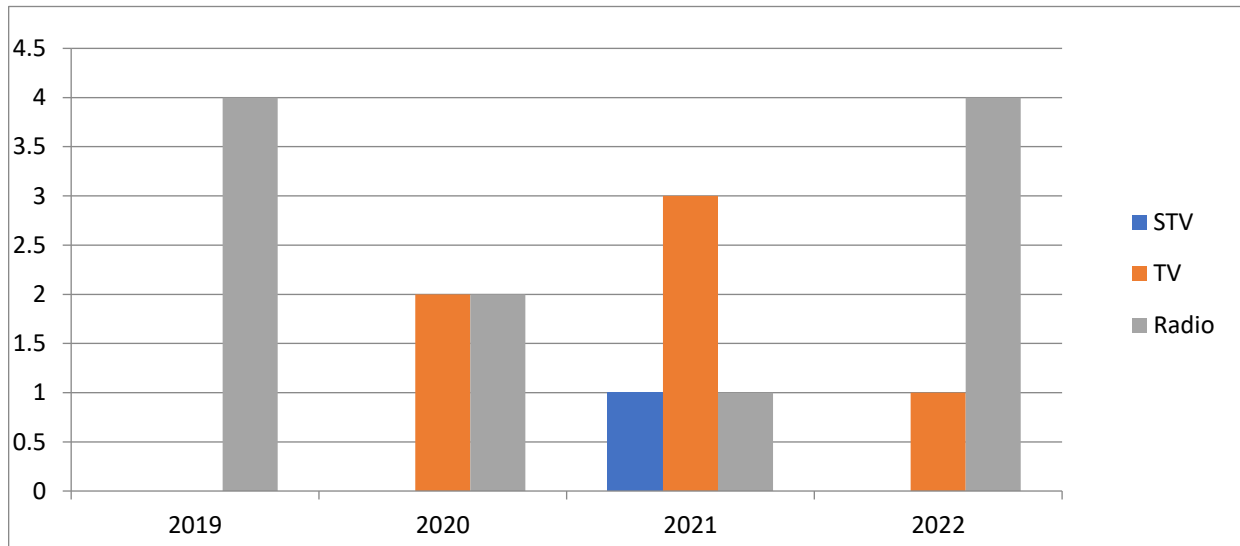
